

Since 1993, I have had the privilege of authoring the **Art Fair SourceBook (AFSB)**, the most comprehensive guide to juried fine art and craft shows on the planet. Created out of necessity by a weary, itinerant artist—myself—who was tired of wasting time, money, and energy on unprofitable art fairs, the AFSB has since become a trusted resource for more than **20,000 artists**.

Over the past 30 years, this guide has helped exhibiting artists and event organizers navigate the art fair world with confidence and success.

Sometimes, however, life gives us signs that it's time for a good thing to come to an end. For me, the signs have been clear:

- The **2020–2021 pandemic** profoundly disrupted the art fair landscape.
- Keeping the AFSB operational beyond 2025 would **require major and** costly software revisions.
- The **unexpected loss of Barbara Jean Yankee**, my longtime Research Assistant and Customer Support Guru, left a void that cannot be readily filled.

After careful reflection, **I've decided to sunset the Art Fair SourceBook at the end of 2025**. While bittersweet, it feels like the right time to close this chapter.

What This Means for You

During this final year, I remain committed to supporting the AFSB community with the following adjustments:

- Focus on the Best Events: The AFSB website will feature a curated list of the best-performing events, with updates including 2026 data throughout 2025.
- **Subscription Adjustments**: All subscriptions, new or renewed after 12/31/24, will expire on December 31, 2025, with pricing prorated accordingly.
- Event Weekly Newsletter: The AFSB Event Weekly will continue to be published throughout 2025.
- Final Top Ten Release: The last AFSB Top Ten Event Lists will be released in early January 2026.
